This Initial Consultation Agreement (“Agreement”) is made between between Regulated Canadian Immigration Consultant (RCIC) **MOHAMMED LAHROUM**, for: Lahroum Canada services d'immigration Inc. (the “RCIC”) R713199 , located at 212-935 BOUL DECARIE MONTREAL QC, H4L3M3 Canada and the above-mentioned client (“Client”).

WHEREAS Client and RCIC wish to enter into a written agreement which contains terms and conditions upon which RCIC will provide his services to Client.

AND WHEREAS RCIC is a licensee of the College of Immigration and Citizenship Consultants (the “College”), the regulator in Canada for immigration consultants.

IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants contained in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

1. Service scope

In consideration of the fee paid and the matter stated above, RCIC agrees to do the

1) Consultation interview

30/60 minutes interview by videoconference, telephone or in person in order to:

- collect and review information regarding Client and his/her immigration project;

- give professional advice to Client;

2) Additional consultations (optional)

- Additional consultations help Client make his/her final decision.
- After the consultation interview, if Client still has some additional questions,
- he/she can request 1 free consultation by email with up to 5 questions.

3) Consultation

report

- Client will receive a consultation report after the interview, including interview
- Summary, advice and useful resources.
- The Agreement is terminated after the report delivery.

•After termination of the Agreement, if Client needs further services, a specific service agreement, such as

retainer agreement, should be signed between the two parties.

2. Client's responsibility

Client must provide RCIC with such factual information and necessary documentation as are required to perform the consultation. Client must be accurate and honest and must inform RCIC of all information, even if negative or adverse, which might be relevant to the advice provided by RCIC in this matter.

Failure to fully disclose all relevant information to RCIC will impact the advice given by RCIC and may void this Agreement, or seriously affect the outcome of the application of Client or the retention of any status that.

Client may obtain.

3. Consultation fee, payment and invoice

- Client should pay initial consultation fee of \$150/250 CAD (non-refundable) upon booking online. RCIC will provide invoice to Client upon receipt of Client's payment.
- If Client signs a retainer agreement with RCIC, the payment made by Client for the initial

consultation can be used to deduct the expenses incurred by the subsequent services in the retainer agreement.

- If Client books more than one consultation, only the first one (initial consultation) will be used for deduction.

4. Governing law

- This Agreement shall be governed by the laws in effect in the Province of Quebec and the federal laws of Canada applicable therein.

5. Confidentiality

- All information and documentation reviewed by RCIC, required by IRCC and all other governing bodies, and
- used for the consultation will not be divulged to any third party, other than agents and employees of RCIC,
- without prior consent, except as demanded by the College or required under law. RCIC, and all agents and
- employees of RCIC, are also bound by the confidentiality requirements of Article 8 of the Code of Professional Conduct.
- Client agrees to the use of electronic communication and storage of confidential information. RCIC will use
- his best efforts to maintain a high degree of security for electronic communication and information storage.

6. Cancellation

- In case that RCIC believes Client has no pathway to immigrate to Canada after review of all information and
- documentation provided by Client, or Client's short-term situation does not meet the requirements for
- Canada immigration (permanent or temporary), RCIC reserves the right to cancel the consultation interview
- and refund Client accordingly.

7. Coming into effect

- Both parties agree that this Agreement does not need to be signed electronically or physically,

and the

- Agreement will come into effect after Client completes the online booking and pays the consultation fee.
- IN WITNESS THEREOF, this Agreement has been duly executed by the parties hereto on the date first above written.
